Reference: FUTA – Indiana, Michigan, & South Carolina

Most of the time - and for most states - the FUTA rate used for payroll calculations is 0.8%. This is because the federal rate is 6.2% but a credit for contributions to state funds of 5.4% is subtracted, resulting in a net of 0.8%. Currently an unusual situation has occurred in Indiana, Michigan, and South Carolina. Because of the high rate of unemployment which has existed in these states the FUTA rate which employers in these states must pay has increased as follows:

- ***The FUTA rate in 2011 for Indiana employers is 1.1%.***
 - This means that, instead of the “0.8” which we show for your FUTA calculation in table 1 of this document, Indiana employers will use a “1.1”.
- ***The FUTA rate in 2011 for Michigan employers is 1.4%.***
 - This means that, instead of the “0.8” which we show for your FUTA calculation in table 1 of this document, Michigan employers will use a “1.4”.
- ***The FUTA rate in 2011 for South Carolina employers is 1.1%.***
 - This means that, instead of the “0.8” which we show for your FUTA calculation in table 1 of this document, South Carolina employers will use a “1.1”.
